Students will explore elements of the author's craft in mentor texts and apply these techniques in their own writing.

They will plan and draft short creative writing pieces experimenting with sentence lengths and types to further develop sentence fluency.

Students will explore how prefixes and suffixes change the meaning of words.

They will edit their writing for meaning, spelling and punctuation.
